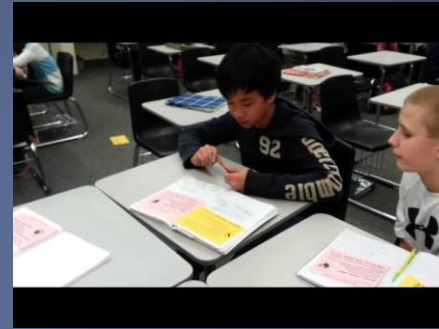
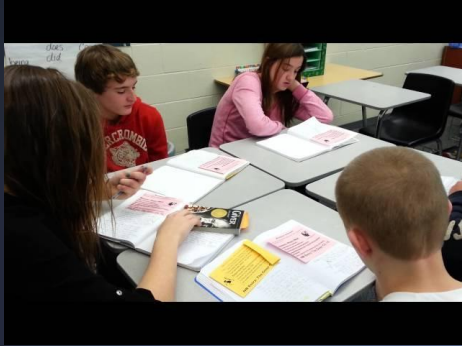
What is the Micro Lab Protocol?

- A structured way of having students discuss a topic in a way that allows all voices and ideas to be heard before discussing as a class.
- A routine that can be easily incorporated into ANY classroom, subject area or lesson.

Why should I use the Micro Lab Protocol in my classroom?

- When students discuss in groups, groups can get sidetracked, one person can dominate while others sit back, students talk over each other and don't listen, etc.
- Micro Lab is designed to ensure everyone participates equally.
