

# Numbered Heads

## Description:

Numbered Heads can be used to encourage small group discussion and make all group members responsible for the possibility of reporting out to the class.

## How to Use the Strategy:

1. Place students in groups of four.
2. Students number off.
3. Teacher gives each group a topic for discussion (each group could also receive a different topic)





# Numbered Heads

## How to Use the Strategy:

4. Teacher announces to the class that after the small group discussion takes place the teacher will call out a number. Each student with that number will be responsible for reporting out to the class what his/her group discussed.
  5. Teacher allows small groups to discuss for a designated amount of time.
  6. Teacher brings the class back together.
  7. Teacher calls out a number and then calls on a particular group to report out.
  8. The student in the group that is called upon and that has that number stands and answers the question or summarizes their group's discussion.
